## Rangoon's Rare International Cuisines

RANGOON — Asian cuisines from China, Japan, Korea, Thailand and India are not considered unconventional among food lovers in Rangoon. But German, Russian and Mediterranean dishes challenge the traditional palate and offer an opportunity to try flavors not available in Rangoon until now. The Foodie Myanmar guide profiles five restaurants below which offer “rare” eats in the historic capital.

### **Mahlzeit**

The German word “Mahlzeit” is a salutation translating to “mealtime” in English. The charmingly decorated eatery offers traditional German foods such as sausages, chicken schnitzel, and German beef roulade—with a cheeseburger. The restaurant lies at No. 84, Pun Hlaing Street in Sanchaung Township.
